



The situation in Rome








- 1. What is going on in Rome?
 - Is it because of meat offered to idols?
 - Is it the Jews and the Sabbath and food rules?
 - Is it because of Gentile ascetics?

2. What does "weak in the faith" mean here?

- NOT believers in name only
- NOT uncertain if Jesus is Messiah
- NOT uncommitted to the Lord
- NOT without self control

These brethren are (*at present*) without enough revelation and faith to see beyond these earthly things.

3. What does Paul want the Romans to do?

Receive him!

- Philemon 1:12, 17
- Romans 14:3
- Romans 15:7



NKJV: ...not to disputes over doubtful things.

- ESV: ...not to quarrel over opinions.
- NIV: ...without quarreling over disputable matters.
- CSB: ...don't argue about disputed matters.
- NASB: ...not for the purpose of passing judgment on his opinions.

4. Why must the weak in the faith be received?


- God has received them (Romans 14:3)

- They do those things unto the Lord (Romans 14:6)

 - We must all give an account of ourselves to God (Romans 14:12)

5. Who is right?


If anyone preaches any other gospel to you ... let him be accursed.
