Tryphena and **Tryphosa**, who have laboured in the Lord.


The beloved **Persis**, who laboured much in the Lord. (Romans 16:12)

Why?

Phoebe; Priscilla, Aquila and the church that is in their house; Epaenetus; Mary; Andronicus and Junia; Amplias; Urbanus; Stachys; Apelles; the household of Aristobulus; Herodion; the household of Narcissus; Tryphena and Tryphosa; Persis; Rufus and his mother; Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes and the brethren who are with them; Philologus and Julia, Nereus and his sister, Olympas and all the saints who are with them; Timothy; Lucius; Jason; Sosipater; Tertius; Gaius; Erastus; Quartus.

Now I urge you, brethren, **note** those who cause **divisions** and **offenses**, contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and **avoid** them.
