I did not come to destroy but to fulfill."


(Matthew 5:17)

## God spoke...

### In the prophets...

- Fragmented
- Incomplete
- Preparatory

## In [His] Son...

- Whole
- Complete
- Final

#### The Son is the full and final word

All others are forerunners of Him or witnesses to Him

Literally "in Son". The focus is character or nature rather than person. (also Hebrews 5:8 "...though [a] Son...")

## God ... has ... spoken to us in [His] Son...

#### It is God Himself who speaks

- Not another neither prophet nor angel
- ➤ Not by the Holy Spirit through a (sinful) man
- Not as the Father

but as Himself the divine person, the incarnate Son

The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

(John 1:14)

## God ... has ... spoken to us in [His] Son...

- Whom He has appointed heir of all things,
- Through whom also He made the worlds;
- Who being the brightness of His glory, and
- The exact imprint of His nature, and
- Upholding all things by the word of His power,
- When He had purged sins,
- Sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high...

(Hebrews 1:2-3)

## Whom He has appointed heir of all things...

Ask of Me, and I will give You

The nations for Your inheritance,

And the ends of the earth for Your possession.

(Psalms 2:8)

The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.

(John 3:35)

All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

(Matthew 28:18)

## Through whom He made the worlds...

Literally: "the ages" = the universe

All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

(John 1:3)

For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers.

All things were created through Him and for Him.

(Colossians 1:16)



## The exact imprint of His nature...





No one has seen God at any time.
The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, **He has declared Him**.

(John 1:18)

He who has seen Me has seen the Father.

(John 14:9)

## Upholding all things by the word of His power...

Or continue, endure, exist

He Himself is before all things and all things are held together in Him.

(Colossians 1:17)

## He purged sins...

Or "accomplished a purification of sins"

> For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh...

(Romans 8:3)

(Ephesians 1:20-22)

## He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high...

He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.

And He put all things under His feet...

## ...having become so much better than the angels

(Hebrews 1:4)

[You] who have received the law by the direction of angels ... (Acts 7:53)

[The law] was appointed **through angels** by the hand of a mediator. (Galatians 3:19)

If the word spoken **through angels** proved steadfast ... (Hebrews 2:2)

...as He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.

(Hebrews 1:4)

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow...

(Philippians 2:9-10)

# At the name of Jesus every knee shall bow...
