


Teaching at a school for the poor

They are now known collectively as Vanuatu








1839 - John Williams was clubbed to death and eaten.

To the island of Tanna








THE ATTACK ON THE MISSION HOUSE.


Paton's 4th son, Frank served in Tanna as a missionary.


