


What are we reading?

A "word of exhortation"

(Hebrews 13:22, Acts 13:15) to those who believe

God spoke

- In many parts and many ways
- In times past
- To the fathers
- In the prophets



But now

- (Fully and finally)
- In these last days
- To us
- In [His] Son

The Son Whom He has appointed heir of all things...

Greater than the angels!

God has spoken to us in [His] Son...

It is God Himself who speaks

- > Not another neither prophet nor angel
- > Not by the Holy Spirit through a (sinful) man
- Not as the Father

but as Himself the divine person, the incarnate Son

God has spoken to us in [His] Son...

- He is the heir of all things
- He made the worlds
