



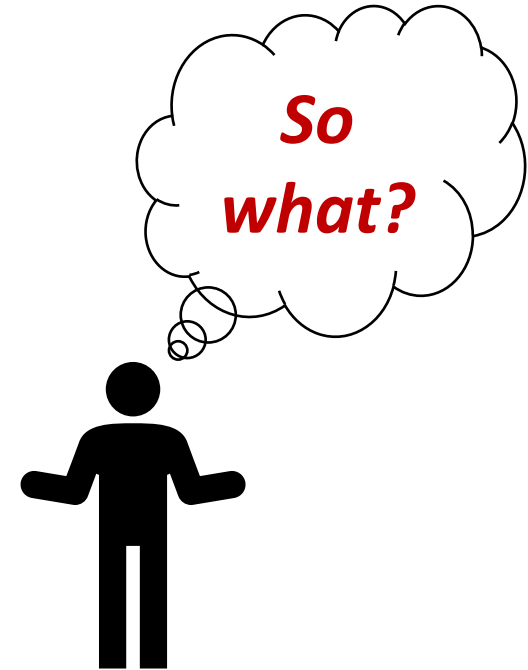

The message of Hebrews 2:5-18

1. God has a great purpose for mankind (not angels) (v. 5-8)
2. It has not yet been accomplished, “*but we see Jesus...*” (v. 8-9)
3. His humiliation and suffering were necessary (v. 10-16)
4. He has become a merciful and faithful **High Priest** (v. 17-18)

and they shall reign on the earth.”*


