The man Christ Jesus has been glorified


(He is so much greater than the angels)

How shall we escape if we **neglect** so great a salvation...?



The message of Hebrews 2:5-18

- 1. God has a great purpose for mankind (not angels) (v. 5-8)
- 2. It has not yet been accomplished, "but we see Jesus..." (v. 8-9)
- 3. His humiliation and suffering were necessary (v. 10-16)
- 4. He has become a merciful and faithful High Priest (v. 17-18)

The inhabited earth the world of people and civilizations.

He has not put **the world to come**, of which we speak, in subjection to angels.

(Hebrews 2:5)

"You were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God ... **and they shall reign on the earth**."

(Revelation 5:9,10)

Psalm 8: What is man...? Or "for a little while"

You have made him a little lower than the angels; You have crowned him with glory and honour...

Or "for a little while"

But we see Jesus,

who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honour, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.
