
2. What about Moses?

- > We have a High Priest at the throne of grace.



Hebrews 3:1 - Carefully chosen words...




Moses	Christ Jesus
Faithful to Him who appointed Him	Faithful to Him who appointed Him
Faithful in God's house as a servant	Faithful in His own house as a Son
Israel was God's house	We are Christ's house
A servant ruler and intercessor (Exodus 32:11-14, 31-32)	The Son - both King and High Priest
A shadow or picture or type The substance and fulfillment

Hardened through the deceitfulness of sin...


