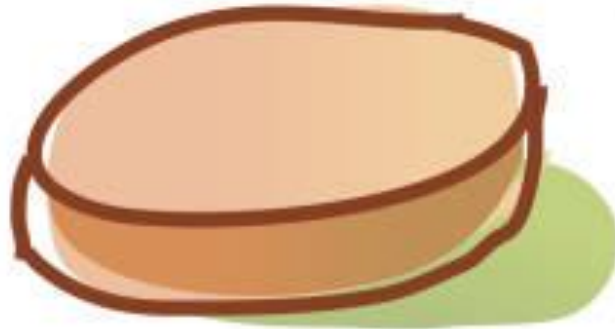

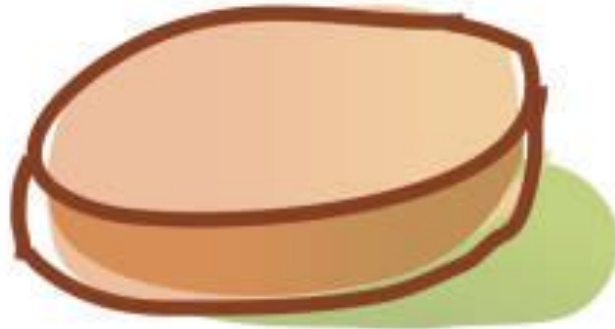

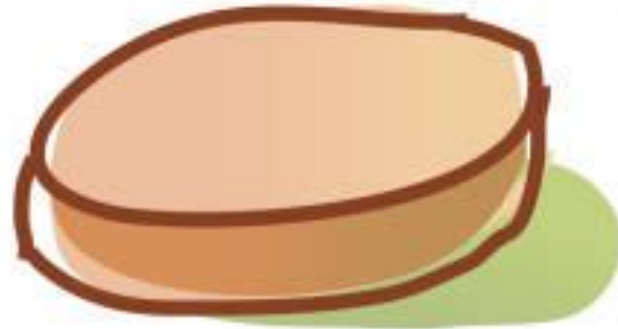

in our hope.**



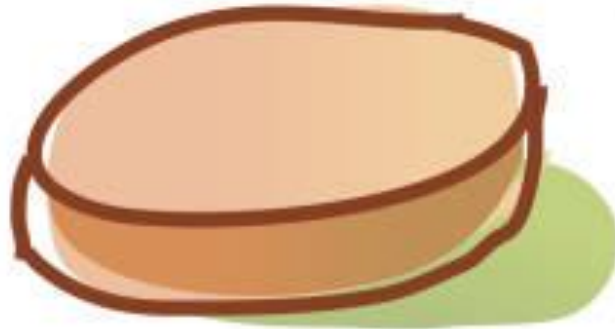

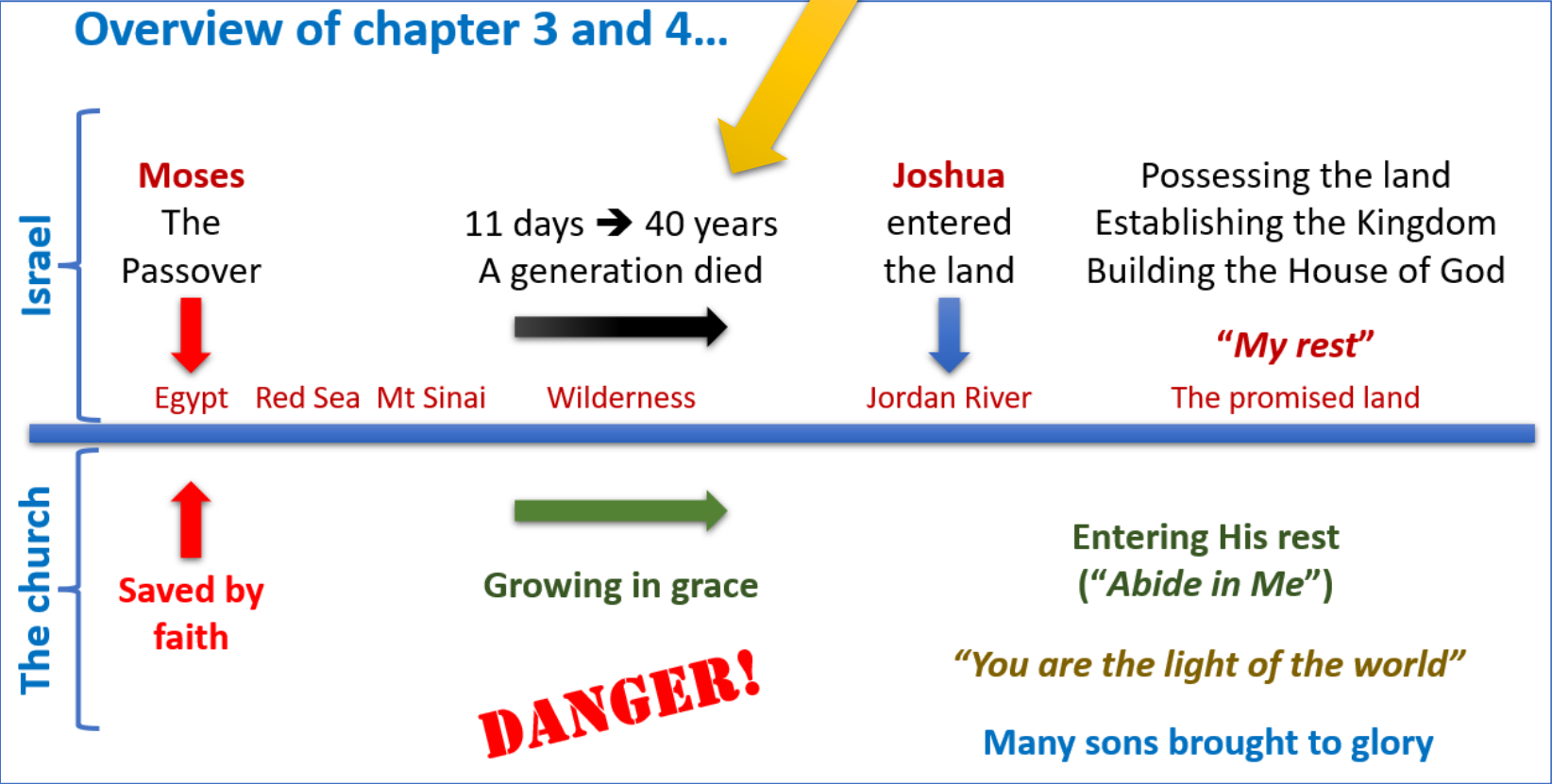
