# Chapter 1, 2 = The Birth of Samuel

### Chapter 1:1-7

1 Now there was a certain man of Ramathaim Zophim, of the mountains of Ephraim, and his name was Elkanah the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephraimite. <sup>2</sup> And he had two wives: the name of one was Hannah, and the name of the other Peninnah. Peninnah had children, but Hannah had no children. <sup>3</sup> This man went up from his city yearly to worship and sacrifice to the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. Also the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the LORD, were there. <sup>4</sup> And whenever the time came for Elkanah to make an offering, he would give portions to Peninnah his wife and to all her sons and daughters. <sup>5</sup> But to Hannah he would give a double portion, for he loved Hannah, although the LORD had closed her womb. <sup>6</sup> And her rival also provoked her severely, to make her miserable, because the LORD had closed her womb. <sup>7</sup> So it was, year by year, when she went up to the house of the LORD, that she provoked her; therefore she wept and did not eat.

### **Chapter 1:10-11**

<sup>10</sup> And she *was* in <u>bitterness</u> of soul, and <u>prayed to the LORD</u> and wept in anguish. <sup>11</sup> Then she made a vow and said, "O LORD of hosts, if You will indeed <u>look on the affliction</u> of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, but will give Your maidservant a male child, then I will <u>give him to the LORD</u> all the days of his life, and <u>no razor</u> shall come upon his head."

### The Affliction of Hannah

### 1. Why? (purpose)

#### Exodus 3: 7 – 8

<sup>7</sup> And the LORD said: "I have surely <u>seen</u> the oppression of My people who *are* in Egypt, and have <u>heard</u> their cry because of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows. <sup>8</sup> So I have <u>come</u> down to <u>deliver</u> them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a <u>good</u> and large <u>land</u>, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites.

### **Philippians 3:8**

Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ.

### (iv) Trust

#### 1 Samuel 1:18

And she said, "Let your maidservant find favour in your sight." So the woman went her way and ate, and her face was no longer sad.

### (v) Dedicate

#### 1 Samuel 1:20-22

<sup>20</sup> So it came to pass in the process of time that Hannah conceived and bore a son, and called his name Samuel, *saying*, "Because I have asked for him from the LORD."

<sup>21</sup> Now the man Elkanah and all his house went up to offer to the LORD the yearly sacrifice and his vow. <sup>22</sup> But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her husband,

"Not until the child is weaned; then I will take him, that he may appear before the LORD and remain there forever."

#### 1 Samuel 1:28

Therefore I also have lent him to the LORD; as long as he lives he shall be <u>lent (dedicate)</u> to the LORD." So they worshiped the LORD there.

# The Prayer of Hannah

2 And Hannah prayed and said: "My heart rejoices in the LORD; My horn is exalted in the LORD. I smile at my enemies, Because I rejoice in Your salvation. <sup>2</sup> "No one is holy like the LORD, For there is none besides You, Nor is there any rock like our God. <sup>3</sup> "Talk no more so very proudly; Let no arrogance come from your mouth,

For the LORD is the God of knowledge; And by Him actions are weighed. <sup>4</sup> "The bows of the mighty men are broken, And those who stumbled are girded with strength. <sup>5</sup> Those who were full have hired themselves out for bread,

And the hungry have ceased to

hunger.

Even the barren has borne seven, And she who has many children has become feeble.

6 "The LORD kills and makes alive; He brings down to the grave and brings up.

<sup>7</sup>The LORD makes poor and makes rich;

He brings low and lifts up.

<sup>8</sup> He raises the poor from the dust *And* lifts the beggar from the ash heap,

To set *them* among princes And make them inherit the throne of glory. "For the pillars of the earth are the LORD's,
And He has set the world upon them.

9 He will guard the feet of His saints,
But the wicked shall be silent in darkness.

"For by strength no man shall prevail.

10 The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken in pieces;

From heaven He will thunder against them.

The LORD will judge the ends of the earth.

"He will give strength to His king, And exalt the horn of His anointed."

#### 1 Samuel 2:21

And the LORD visited Hannah, so that she conceived and bore <u>three sons</u> and <u>two daughters</u>. Meanwhile the child Samuel grew before the LORD.
