


- Where are we up to?

The historical background to "His rest"



What went wrong? (see Numbers 13)

We went to the land ...
It truly flows with milk
and honey ...

Nevertheless, the people who dwell in the land are strong...

Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it.

If the Lord delights in us, then **He will bring us** into this land and give it to us...

(Numbers 14:8)

What is "His Rest"?

He who has entered His rest has himself **also** ceased from his works as God did from His.

(Hebrews 4:10)

What is "His Rest"?

- It is not simply "a rest"
- God rests when His work is finished
- His rest is His finished work made available to us







What is a High Priest?

- > The clothing of the High Priest
 - The onyx stones
 - The breastplate
- ➤ The Day of Atonement



The Onyx Stones

Then you shall take two onyx stones and engrave on them the names of the sons of Israel...

So Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD on his two shoulders as a memorial.

(Exodus 28:9,12)



The Breastplate



You shall set in it four rows of stones...

There shall be twelve stones with their names according to the names of the sons of Israel.

(Exodus 28:17,21)



The Breastplate



Wisdom and guidance

And you shall put in the breastplate of judgment the **Urim and the Thummim**, and they shall be over Aaron's heart when he goes in before the LORD.

So Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel over his heart before the LORD continually.

(Exodus 28:30)

The Day of Atonement

The 10th day of the 7th month

Israel was totally dependant on the High Priest

the priest shall make atonement for you, to cleanse you, that you may be clean from all your sins before the LORD. It is a sabbath of solemn rest for you...

(Leviticus 16:30-31)

(Hebrews 4:15)

No temptation has overtaken you except such as is **common to man**... (1 Corinthians 10:13)

Our weaknesses...


Body:
