

The historical background





Now these things happened to them as an example, but **they were written down for our instruction**, on whom the end of the ages has come. (1 Corinthians 10:11)

The Sabbath Day


Surely My Sabbaths you shall keep, for it is a sign between Me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I am the Lord who sanctifies you.

I am the vine, you are the branches



Let us therefore strive **to enter that rest**, so that no one may fall by the **same sort of disobedience**. (Hebrews 4:11)



Numbers 13

We went to the land ... It truly flows with milk and honey ... **Nevertheless**, the people who dwell in the land are strong...

Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it. If the Lord delights in us, then **He will bring us** into this land and give it to us...

(Numbers 14:8)

Let us therefore strive to enter that rest...

For the word of God is living and active ... discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. (Hebrews 4:12)



- We must see that it is **His rest**, not simply a rest
- We must believe in the resurrection of Jesus
- We must actively live our faith
