but you were not willing!

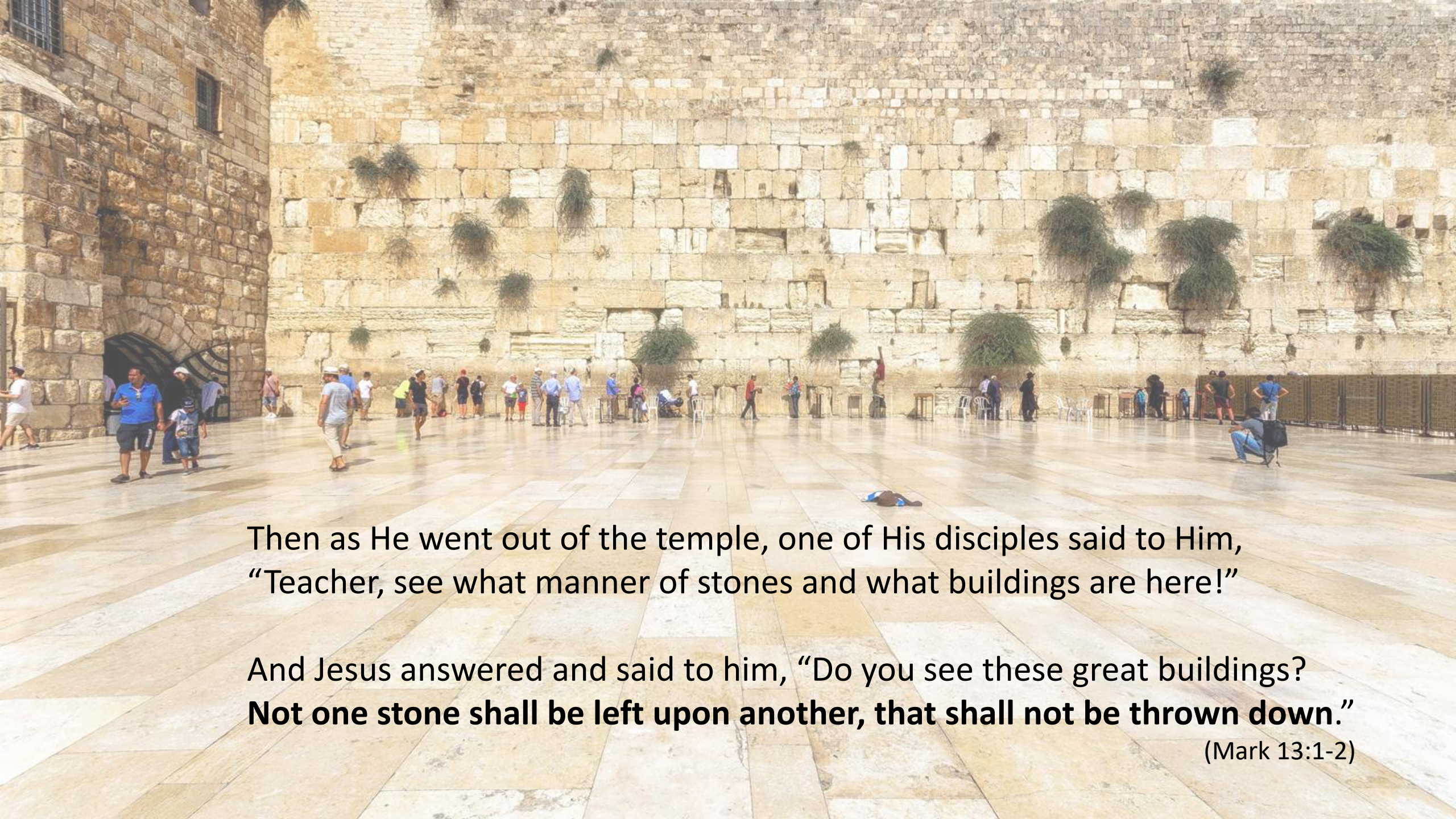

(Matthew 23:39)


Then Jesus went out

(Matthew 24:14)




“When you see the '**abomination of desolation,**'

(Daniel 9:27)



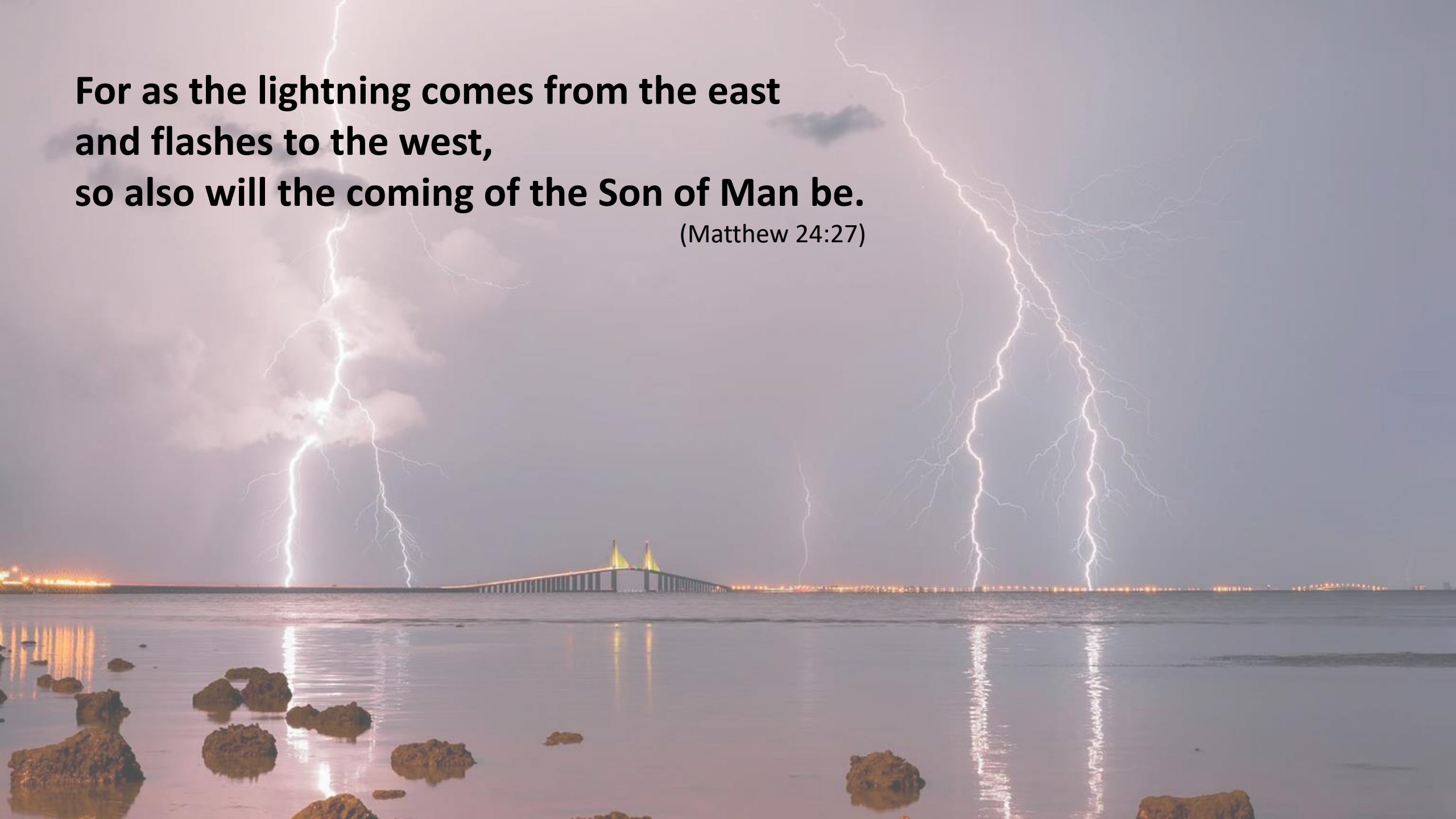
Affliction, anguish,

The Son of Man is coming at an hour **you do not expect.**

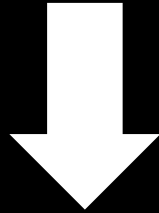
