





What is a High Priest?

- ➤ The clothing of the High Priest
 - The onyx stones
 - The breastplate
- ➤ The Day of Atonement



The Onyx Stones

Then you shall take two onyx stones and engrave on them the names of the sons of Israel...

So Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD on his two shoulders as a memorial.

(Exodus 28:9,12)



The Breastplate



And you shall put in the breastplate of judgment the **Urim and the Thummim**, and they shall be over Aaron's heart when he goes in before the LORD.

So Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel over his heart before the LORD continually.

(Exodus 28:30)

The Day of Atonement

For on that day the priest shall make atonement for you, to cleanse you, that you may be clean from all your sins before the LORD. It is a sabbath of solemn rest for you...

(Leviticus 16:30-31)

The conclusion...

Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God,

let us hold fast our confession.

For we do not have a **High Priest** who is unable to sympathise with our **weaknesses**, but one who in every respect has been **tempted as we are**, **yet without sin**.

(Hebrews 4:14-15)

Our weaknesses...


Body:

The great High Priest, Jesus, the Son of God


Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Israel's High Priest	The Son of God
Taken from among men	• "For unto us a child is born" (Isaiah 9:6)
 Appointed for the things of God 	• "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me" (Luke 4:18)
 He offers gifts and sacrifices for sins 	• "Behold the Lamb of God" (John 1:29)
 He is subject to weakness 	• "He was asleep on a pillow" (Mark 4:38)
He is called by God	• "You are a priest forever" (Psalm 110:4)

Who is Melchizedek?

A name for Jerusalem (see Psalm 76:2)

Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the priest of God Most High.

(Genesis 14:18)

Psalm 2:7

"You are My Son,
Today I have begotten You."

(Hebrews 5:5)

Like Aaron, but ...

An entirely different order

Psalm 110:4

"You are a priest forever

According to the order of **Melchizedek**"

(Hebrews 5:6)

He experienced obedience in the weakness of a human nature

Though He was [a] Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered.

And having been **perfected**,
He became **the author of eternal salvation**to all who obey Him,

called by God as High Priest

"according to the order of Melchizedek"

(Hebrews 5:8-10)

For it was fitting for Him ...

in bringing many sons to glory,

to make the captain of their salvation

perfect through sufferings.

(Hebrews 2:10)







