YOUNG KING SOLOMON

Scriptures: 1 KINGS chapter 1-5

- Background story:
- King David died, his son Solomon succeeded him as new king
- Age of King Solomon
- Not very clear, surely very young



SOLOWON'S DREAM

- 1 Kings 3:3-9
- 3 Solomon loved the Lord, walking in the statues of David his father, only sacrificed and made offerings at the high places
- 4 and the king went to Gibeon to sacrifice there, for that was the great high place. Solomon used to offer a thousand burnt offerings on that altar
- 5 At Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream by night, and God said, "Ask what I shall give you."

- Riches
- Health
- War victory
- Make his country great
- life of enemies

SOLOMON'S REQUEST

- 6 And Solomon said, "You have shown great and steadfast love to your servant David my father, because he walked before you in faithfulness, in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart towards you.
- And you have kept for him this great and steadfast love and have given him a son to sit on his throne this day"



ALL WHAT I HAVE FROM GOD

- Give thanks to LORD for giving kingdom to his father David and him
- David' kingdom from LORD
- LORD makes Solomon the king
- Not the oldest one
- Not the strongest one
- Not the most popular one
- (Older brother Adonijah)



- 7 And now, O LORD my God, you have made your servant king in place of David my father, although I am a little child. I do not know how to go out or come in.
- And your servant is in the midst of your people whom you have chosen, a great people, too many to be numbered or counted for multitude
- 9 give your servant therefore an understanding mind to govern your people, that I may discern between good and evil, for who is able to govern this great people?



BIG CONCERNS

- realized he is too young and no much experience
- no time to prepare to be a king
- In ancient China, before an old emperor stepped down, new emperor will have time to practice, to learn how to govern the country
- Too much to learn
- Leadership, Economy, politics, culture, justice, diplomacy, war...
- Too young
- If not doing well, someone better will come up and replace him



TO BE A GOOD KING

- King Solomon's prayer
- Give your servant therefore an understanding mind to govern your people, that I may discern between good and evil

- Be a good king
- How to shepherd Israel people

THE WAY PLEASED LORD

- 10 It pleased the Lord that Solomon has asked this
- 11 And God said to him, "Because you have asked this, and have not asked for yourself long life or riches or the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern what is right
- 12 behold, I now do according your word. Behold, I give you a wise and discerning mind, so that none like you has been before you and none like you shall arise after you.
- 13 I give you also what you have not asked, both riches and honor, so that no other king shall compare with you, all your days
