Milk and not solid food

















of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands,


of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

"The Father sent the Son as saviour of the world." (1 John 4:14)


Faith toward God

(Acts 13:3)


The laying on of hands
