And this we will do if God permits. (Hebrews 6:1-3)



WHAT DOES HEBREWS 6:4-6 MEAN?



(Hebrews 6:4-6)

What is impossible?

Brethren, if a man is **overtaken in any trespass**, you who are spiritual **restore such a one** in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.

(Galatians 6:1)

Brethren, if anyone among you **wanders from the truth**, and someone **turns him back**, let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save **a soul from death** and cover a multitude of sins. (James 5:19-20)

What is impossible?

If anyone sees his brother **sinning a sin** which does **not** lead to death, **he will ask, and He will give him life** for those who commit sin not leading to death. (1 John 5:16)

= Die

For this reason many are **weak and sick** among you, and many **sleep**.

For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged.

But when we are judged, we are chastened by the Lord,

that we may not be **condemned** with the world.

(1 Corinthians 11:30-32)

if they fall away,


to **renew** them **again** to repentance, since they are **crucifying again** for themselves the Son of God, and putting Him to an open shame.

But, beloved...


Inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these **my brethren**, you did it to me. (Matthew 25:40)

Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. (Galatians 6:7)






We desire that **each one of you** ... imitate those who through **faith and patience inherit the promises**.

And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.


(Hebrews 6:15)
