


What is the main point?




We have such a **High Priest**,

who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens,

a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man.

(Hebrews 8:1-2)

Jesus, the Messiah:

"You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek." (Psalm 110:4)

When there is a change in the priesthood, there is necessarily a change in the law... (Hebrews 7:12)



The Law is set aside...

On the one hand,

a former command is **set aside** because it was weak and useless, **for the law made nothing perfect**; By the deeds of the law **no flesh will be justified** in His sight, for by the law is **the knowledge of sin**. (Romans 3:20)

on the other hand,

a **better hope** is introduced, through which **we draw near to God**. (Hebrews 7:18-19) The better hope has come...

We now draw near to God (7:19)

The Lord Jesus guarantees the better covenant (7:22)

He is able to save to the uttermost Completely, perfectly because He always lives to intercede for us (7:25)

The greatness of this salvation is measured by the greatness of God's Son

The greatness of God's Son...

- He is the heir of all things
- He created the world
- He is the radiance of God's glory
- He is the exact imprint of God's nature
- He upholds all things by the word of His power
- He has cleansed sin
- He is seated at the right hand of God

(From Hebrews 1:1-3)

He knows our eternal salvation weaknesses



- With living hope, the anchor of the soul




A High Priest, who knows our weaknesses and is at the right hand of God, always living to make intercession for us...

Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD on his two shoulders as a memorial.

(Exodus 28:12)

Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel over his heart before the LORD continually. (Exodus 28:30)
