Because He entered in with His own blood



Provision for our present pilgrimage

The ashes of a heifer...

Numbers 19:

- Take a red heifer without blemish
- It shall be slaughtered outside the camp
- Its blood shall be sprinkled before the Tabernacle
- It shall be burned
- Its ashes shall be gathered up and stored outside the camp in a clean place
- The ashes shall be used in "the water of purification".

➤ It is for purifying from sin

- Whoever touches a dead body shall be unclean for seven days.
- He shall purify himself with the water on the third day and on the seventh day
- > Then he will be clean.



If we confess our sins,

He is faithful and just

to forgive us our sins

AND to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
