


### 2. Pentecost

#### "But who do you say that I am?"

Death

"You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

"Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven.

πέτρος (petros) = a

πέτρα (petra) = a (mass of) rock.

And I also say to you that you are Peter, (piece of) rock or a stone and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it."

(Matthew 16:15-18)

# > I will build My church

ἐκκλησία (ekklēsia) = literally: a calling out, hence an assembly...

"This is that Moses ... who was in the **congregation** in the wilderness with the Angel who spoke to him on Mount Sinai...

(Acts 7:37-38)



Therefore, if Demetrius and his fellow craftsmen have a case against anyone ... let them bring charges against one another. But if you have any other inquiry to make, it shall be determined in the lawful **assembly**.


And when he had said these things, he dismissed the assembly.

# What's the difference? Sealed by the Holy Spirit!

ἀἀρὸαβών (arrhabōn)
= part of the
property given in
advance as security
for the rest.

In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.

(Ephesians 1:13-14)

And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.


And tongues as of fire appeared to them, distributed among them, and rested upon each of them

# What happened?

#### Verse 4

The multitude came together, and were confused, because everyone heard them speak in his own language.

# "We hear them speaking in our own tongues the wonderful works of God."


What were they saying?
