From Psalm 40:

Set apart, cleansed

In that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

(Hebrews 10:10)

But this One, after He had offered **one sacrifice** for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God...

The New Covenant...


It is the **blood**that makes
atonement for
the soul.
(Leviticus 17:11)

This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is shed for you.

(Luke 22:20)

"This is the covenant I will make...

Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."



Now where there is **forgiveness** of these, there is no longer **an offering for sin**.

(Hebrews 10:18)

The Son is greater than the whole Levitical order

...of whom we have much to say, and hard to explain... (Hebrews 5:11)

"You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."

(Hebrews 5:6 quoting Psalm 110:4)

We do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathise with our weaknesses... (Hebrews 4:15)



The law made nothing perfect; on the other hand, there is the bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God.

(Hebrews 7:19)

He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

(Hebrews 7:25)

But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises.

(Hebrews 8:6)

"...all shall know Me...

For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."

(Hebrews 8:11-12 quoting Jeremiah 31:34)

The way into the Holiest of All was **not yet** made manifest...

(Hebrews 9:8)

The presence of God

With His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all,

having obtained eternal redemption.

(Hebrews 9:12)

He is the Mediator of the new covenant... that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

(Hebrews 9:15)

...Christ was offered **once** to bear the sins of many.

To those who eagerly wait for Him

He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

(Hebrews 9:27-28)

The High Priest coming out of the Most Holy Place

By one offering

He has perfected forever

those who are being sanctified.

(Hebrews 10:14)

Now there were certain Greeks among those who came up to worship at the feast.


(John 12:20)
