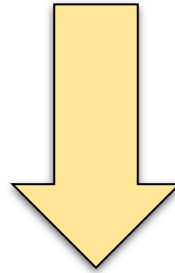

# A warning

For if we **go on sinning deliberately** after receiving the knowledge of the truth,

...those who were once enlightened...  
(Hebrews 6:4)

there no longer remains **a sacrifice** for sins,

Because it has been rejected

but a certain fearful expectation of **judgment**, and a fury of fire that will consume the adversaries.

(Hebrews 10:26-27)

Christ was offered once to bear the **sins** of many  
(Hebrews 9:28)

The **blood of Jesus Christ** cleanses us from all **sin**  
(1 John 1:7)

**Sinful humanity**




**The wrath of God**

If anyone competes in **athletics**, he must compete according to the rules.

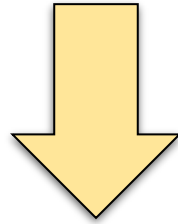
The hardworking **farmer** must be first to partake of the crops.
