A warning

For if we **go on sinning deliberately** after receiving the knowledge of the truth,

...those who were once enlightened... (Hebrews 6:4)

there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,

Because it has been rejected

but a certain fearful expectation of **judgment**, and a fury of fire that will consume the adversaries.

(Hebrews 10:26-27)

Christ was offered once to bear the **sins** of many (Hebrews 9:28)

Sinful humanity

The blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin (1 John 1:7)

The wrath of God

What is the DELIBERATE SIN?

Trampling underfoot the Son of God

If anyone competes in athletics, he must compete according to the rules.


The hardworking farmer must be first to partake of the crops.
