But what God foretold


by the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer, **He thus fulfilled**. **Repent therefore**, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out...

Moses said,



Genesis 12:3


God, having raised up his servant, **sent him to you first**, **to bless you** by turning every one of you **from your wickedness**.




By what power or by what name have you done this?

(Acts 4:10-12)

Now when they saw the **boldness** of Peter and John, and perceived that they were **uneducated** and **untrained** men, they marveled.

And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

(Acts 4:13)

And seeing the man who had been healed **standing with them**, they could say nothing against it.

(Acts 4:14)

Do not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus! Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge. For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.

(Acts 4:19-20)

But Peter and John answered...

So when they had further **threatened** them, they let them go...

And being let go, they went to their own companions and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said to them.

> And when they heard it, they lifted their voices together to God and said...

Sovereign Lord, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and everything in them,

who through the mouth of our father David, Your servant, said **by the Holy Spirit**,

Why did the Gentiles rage, and the peoples plot in vain? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers were gathered together, against the Lord and against his Anointed (Acts 4:24-26)

Psalm 2:1-2

...for truly in this city there were gathered together against Your holy servant Jesus, whom You anointed,

both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles **and the peoples of Israel**,

to do whatever Your hand and Your plan had predestined to take place.

(Acts 4:27-28)

And now, Lord, look upon their threats and grant to Your servants to continue to speak Your word with all boldness,

while You stretch out Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders are performed through the name of Your holy servant Jesus. (Acts 4:29-30) And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken,

and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit

and continued to speak the word of God with boldness. (Acts 4:31)



WHAT HAVE WE SEEN?

Their message:

- You crucified Him, but God has raised Him
- This was always God's plan, spoken of by the prophets

Their manner:

- In the face of opposition boldness to speak God's word
- In the face of threats prayer for a bold witness
