
"The just shall live by faith"

And real faith impacts **every part** of your life. So how must a Christian live?




Without faith it is impossible to please Him, for the one who draws near to God must believe that:

BY FAITH...


Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come. (Hebrews 11:20)

Jacob, when he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph (Hebrews 11:21)




JOSEPH




