Dear Friends,


"What are Weet-bix?"

Just the other day, we had a rather amusing conversation over breakfast. Joy was teaching Mark the mnemonic "Never eat soggy Weet-bix" for remembering North-East-South-West, when Mark, with complete seriousness, asked, "What are Weet-Bix?"

And then it hit us. That even for our 7 year old - who has technically spent more time in Australia than Uruguay - the transition back to life in Australia will not be an easy one. There will doubtless be many more surprises as we touch down into Sydney airport, and it feels daunting just thinking about how we might help our kids survive (and thrive!) through the challenges.

We've started filling out our "quadrant" - an activity we do as a family before every major life transition. There are many things we're looking forward to about Australia,

and things we won't be sorry to leave in Uruguay. But there are also many things we're going to miss about Uruguay, and things we're not so looking forward to in Australia.

So please keep us in your prayers this month as we prepare to leave! We feel vulnerable and weak, yet strangely confident and secure. Because God is faithful, and so are you, our dear partners in the gospel! Which leads us to the second half of this prayer letter.

3 years ago, we asked you to prayerfully commit yourselves to partnering with us in our work for the gospel in Uruguay. And now 3 years later, we want to thank you for your faithfulness to us.

We would not be leaving Uruguay with hearts full of joy and hope, as we have now, if not for your steadfastness in prayer and generosity in financial giving. Do you remember our S-U-N prayer points? Spanish, university students, and new things? Well, here's what God has done in answer to your intercession for us:

- We are speaking Spanish! Some days are better than others, but we are understanding, communicating, teaching, singing, reading, praying, living, and sometimes even dreaming, in Spanish!
- Our ministry to University students is growing. We have been able to connect
 with them, get to know them, learn from them, bring them into our home, read
 the Bible with them, disciple them, teach them, and train them. There is so
 much more to do, but in these 3 years, we've made a start, and there have
 been many encouragements.
- God has provided for every new thing we have faced: a new home, a new school for Mark (and Zoe too!), new friends and Christian family, a new church, new favourite things. Even a new member of our family, through whom we have been granted permanent residency!

Thank you, dear friends, for your faithfulness towards us. We are truly grateful.


