What sort of faith is this?

Through faith they...

- Subdued kingdoms
- Worked righteousness
- Obtained promises
- Stopped the mouths of lions
- Quenched the power of fire
- Escaped the edge of the sword
- Were made strong out of weakness
- Became mighty in battle
- Put foreign armies to flight
- Raised the dead to life

(See Hebrews 11:33-35)

And because of their faith...

- They were tortured
- > They were mocked and flogged
- They were chained and imprisoned
- They were stoned
- > They were sawn in two
- They were slain with the sword
- They wandered in sheepskins and goatskins
- They were destitute, afflicted, ill-treated
- They wandered in deserts and mountains
- They lived in dens and caves

...of whom the world was not worthy
