6 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <sup>2</sup> “Honor your father and mother” (this is the first commandment with a promise), <sup>3</sup> “that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land.”

Matthew 15:4 (ESV)

For God commanded, ‘**Honor** your father and your mother,’ and, ‘Whoever **reviles** father or mother must surely die.’

Proverb 30:17 (ESV)

The eye that mocks a father  
and scorns to obey a mother  
will be picked out by the ravens of the valley  
and eaten by the vultures.

Jeremiah 29:11-12 (ESV)

<sup>11</sup> For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans **for welfare** and **not for evil**, to give you a future and a hope. <sup>12</sup> Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you.

The way to a redeemed relationship with parents

Gen 50:20 (ESV)

But as for you, **you meant evil** against me; *but* **God meant it for good**, in order to bring it about as *it is* this day, to save many people alive.

Acts 5:29 (ESV)

“We must obey God rather than men.”

Mt 15:4-7 (ESV)

<sup>4</sup> For God commanded, 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'Whoever reviles father or mother must surely die.' <sup>5</sup> But you say, 'If anyone tells his father or his mother, "What you would have gained from me is given to God," <sup>6</sup> he need not honor his father.' So for the sake of your tradition you have made void the word of God. <sup>7</sup> You hypocrites! ...

1 Tim 5:4, 8 (ESV)

<sup>4</sup> But if a widow has children or grandchildren, let them first learn to show godliness to their own household and to **make some return** to their parents, for this is pleasing in the sight of God.

<sup>8</sup> But if anyone does not **provide** for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.



John 19:26-27 (ESV)

<sup>26</sup> When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, “Woman, behold, your son!” <sup>27</sup> Then he said to the disciple, “Behold, your mother!” **And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home.**
