Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? (Matthew 6:25)




Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

3 Be established in grace

You then, my son, **be strong in the grace** that is in Christ Jesus... (2 Timothy 2:1)

Do not be led away by diverse and strange doctrines,

for it is good that **the heart** be **established by grace**,

not by foods, which have not profited those occupied with them. (Hebrews 13:9)

The grace of God ... [teaches] us that... we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Saviour Jesus Christ... (See Titus 2:11-14)
