Revelation?

Blessed is he who **reads** and those who **hear**  
the words of this prophecy,  
and **keep** those things which are written in it;  
**for the time is near.**

(Revelation 1:3)

## What will influence our understanding of Revelation?

- **How we view the Scriptures**
  - 2 Timothy 3:16-17 – “All Scripture is given by inspiration of God...”
- **Our view of Israel’s place in God’s purposes**
  - Romans 11:11 – “Have they stumbled that they should fall?”
- **A prior commitment to a fixed interpretation**
  - Proverbs 3:7 – “Do not be wise in your own eyes...”

## Asking the right questions...

Tell us, when will these things be?  
And what will be the sign of Your coming,  
and of the end of the age?  
(Matthew 24:3)

*Take heed that no one  
deceives you.*  
(Matthew 24:4)

*Therefore you also be ready...*  
(Matthew 24:44)

Lord, will You at this time  
restore the kingdom to Israel?  
(Acts 1:6)

*It is not for you to know times or seasons  
which the Father has put in His own authority.*  
(Acts 1:7)

(Acts 9:6)

*He who has an ear, let him hear  
what the Spirit says to the churches.*  
(Revelation 2:7)

## Jesus Christ

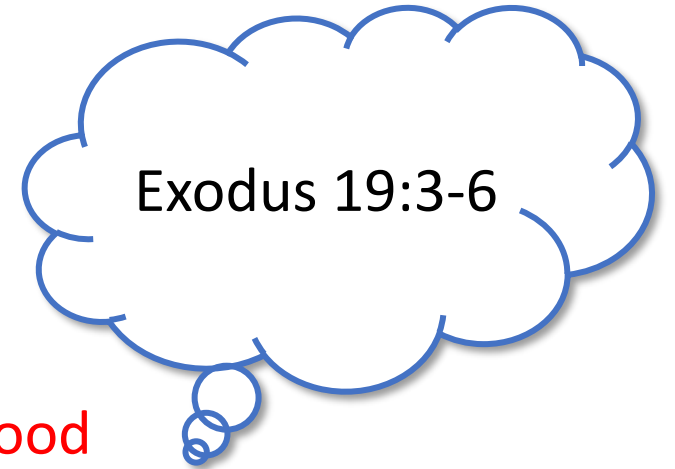
- the faithful witness,
