Its wealth was from trade, being situated on important trade routes.





...that you have a name that you are alive,


but you are dead.

and strengthen what remains and is about to die


for I have not found your works complete in the sight of My God.

Malachi 1:8, 13


Lacking, unfinished or unacceptable (Revelation 3:2)

Hold fast!

Remember therefore

how you have received and heard;

hold fast and repent.

Keep what you have received and heard

(Revelation 3:3)

Change your mind / direction

Beware!

If you will not watch,

Suddenly and unexpectedly

I will come as a thief,

and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.

(Revelation 3:3)

I will come as a thief...

If the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have **watched** ...

Therefore you also **be ready**, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour **you do not expect**.

(Matthew 24:43-44)

That Day ... will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth.

Watch therefore...

(See Luke 21:34-36)

"Behold, I am coming as a thief.

Blessed is he who watches..."

(Revelation 16:15)

The day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night.

(1 Thessalonians 5:2)

But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night...

(2 Peter 3:10)

Just a few...

Yet you have a few names in Sardis who have not **defiled** their garments; and they shall walk with Me in white, for they are worthy.

(Revelation 3:4)

How could they do that?

A gracious promise...

Conquers

He who **overcomes** shall be clothed in white garments,

Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun...
(Matthew 13:43)

and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.

They shall be mine...
(Malachi 3:17)



What have we seen in Sardis?

✓ The Lord expects **LIFE** in His people

Therefore:

✓ We must WATCH and not be defiled

Which means:

- ✓ We must REMEMBER what we have heard
- ✓ We must HOLD FAST to the Word of Life.
- ✓ We must keep a REPENTANT heart
