- He is TRUSTWORTHY and RELIABLE.




God is Almighty (Omnipotent).

God is All-Present (Omnipresence).

Psalm 139: 7 – 10

*⁷ Where shall I go from your Spirit?
Or where shall I flee from your presence?*

*⁸ If I ascend to heaven, you are there!
If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there!*

*⁹ If I take the wings of the morning
and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,*

*¹⁰ even there your hand shall lead me,
and your right hand shall hold me.*



God is All-Knowing (Omniscience).
