
Questions:

- The sons of Israel, God's servants
- To show ownership
 - The Lord's name? (Revelation 14:1)

...harm...only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads. (Revelation 9:4)

And I heard the number of the sealed, **144,000**, sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel... (Revelation 7:4)



12,000 from the tribe of **Judah** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Reuben** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Gad** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Asher** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Naphtali** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Manasseh** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Simeon** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Levi** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Levi** were sealed,



144.000

Judah is first!

What has happened to the tribe of Dan?

- A nation created by God through Abraham and Isaac Genesis 12:2
- A nation to which God spoke and revealed Himself **Deuteronomy 5:7-8**
- The nation to which the Lord Jesus came Micah 5:2, John 1:11
- A nation to which God has made unbreakable promises Jeremiah 31:35-37
- The nation with which the Lord Jesus still identifies Revelation 5:5
- The nation to which the Lord Jesus will return Zechariah 14:3-4, Matthew 23:37-39

Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be **saved**. (Romans 10:1)

Has God cast away His people? **Certainly not!** (Romans 11:1) Have they stumbled that they should fall? **Certainly not!** (See Romans 11:11-15)

A partial hardening has happened to Israel until the full number of the Gentiles has come in. And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; For this is My covenant with them, When I take away their sins.

(Romans 11:25-27)

They are beloved for the sake of their forefathers. (Romans 11:28)

For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. (Romans 11:29)

And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and pleas for mercy, so that,

they will look on Me, on Him whom they have pierced.

They shall mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only child, and weep bitterly over Him, as one weeps over a firstborn. (Zechariah 12:10)

On that day there shall be a fountain opened for the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, to cleanse them from sin and uncleanness.

(Zechariah 13:1)

If the nation of Israel still has a place in God's purposes, should we be surprised by the hatred that Jewish people face?

"Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees, until we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads."

After these things

I looked, and behold,

a great multitude that no one could number,

from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne,

and to the Lamb!" (Revelation 7:9-10)

Joy and celebration

The multitude come out of great tribulation (Revelation 7:9-17)

Who are these, clothed in white robes, and from where have they come?

Sir, you know. 💄

These are the ones coming out of **the great tribulation**. They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Tribulation or trouble Daniel 12:1 ? Matthew 24:21-22 ?

(See Revelation 7:13-17)

The multitude come out of great tribulation (Revelation 7:9-17)

Therefore they are before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple; and He who sits on the throne will shelter them with His presence...

Literally: "will spread His tent over them"

For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd, and He will guide them to springs of living water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.

(Revelation 7:15,17)

Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!

> Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom, thanksgiving and honour and power and might, be to our God forever and ever! Amen. (Revelation 7:12)
