Prelude to the third section...

Revelation 8:2-5

Then I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them.

And another angel came and stood at the altar with a golden censer, and he was given much incense to offer with the prayers of all the saints...

Then the angel took the censer and filled it with fire from the altar and threw it on the earth...



The vision of the first four trumpets...

A third of the earth was burned up, and a third of the trees and all green grass was burned up.

(Revelation 8:7)

A third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

(Revelation 8:9)

A third of the waters became wormwood, and many people died from the water...

(Revelation 8:11)

A third of the sun was struck, and a third of the moon, and a third of the stars... (Revelation 8:12)



The remaining three trumpets...

Then I looked, and I heard an eagle crying with a loud voice as it flew directly overhead,

Woe, woe, woe to those who dwell on the earth, at the blasts of the other trumpets that the three angels are about to blow!

(Revelation 8:13)

Revelation 9:1-21

I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. (Luke 10:18)

...and I saw a star **fallen** from heaven to earth, and he was given the key to the shaft of the bottomless pit.

(Revelation 9:1)

"What is your name?" "Legion."

And they begged Him that He would not command them to go out into **the abyss**.


(See Luke 8:30-31 and Matthew 8:29)

He opened the shaft of the bottomless pit, and from the shaft rose **smoke like the smoke of a great furnace**...

Then from the smoke came locusts on the earth, and they were given power like the power of scorpions of the earth.

(Revelation 9:2-3)



Do not harm the earth...
till we have sealed
the servants of our God...
(Revelation 7:3)

They were told not to harm the grass of the earth or any green plant or any tree, but only those people who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads.

They were allowed to torment them for five months, but not to kill them...

And in those days people will seek death and will not find it.

They will long to die, but death will flee from them.

(Revelation 9:4-6)

The appearance of the locusts...

- They were like horses prepared for battle
- On their heads were what looked like crowns of gold
- Their faces were like human faces
- Their hair was like women's hair
- Their teeth were like lions' teeth
- They had breastplates like breastplates of iron
- The noise of their wings was like many chariots rushing into battle.
- They have tails and stings like scorpions in their tails

(See Revelation 9:7-10)

They have as king over them

the angel of the bottomless pit.

His name in Hebrew is Abaddon,

and in Greek he is called Apollyon.


Destruction

The first woe has passed; behold, two woes are still to come.

(Revelation 9:12)

...and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar before God...

"Release the four angels **who are bound** at the great river Euphrates." (Revelation 9:13-14)




2 x 10,000 x 10,000 = 200,000,000

So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour, the day, the month, and the year, were released to kill a third of mankind.

The number of **mounted troops** was twice ten thousand times ten thousand; I heard their number.

(Revelation 9:15-16)



The appearance of the horses and riders:

- they wore breastplates the color of fire and of sapphire and of sulfur,
- the heads of the horses were like lions' heads,
- fire and smoke and sulfur came out of their mouths.

By these three plagues a third of mankind was killed...

For the power of the horses is in their mouths and in their tails,

for their tails are like serpents with heads,

and by means of them they wound.

(See Revelation 9:17-19)

The rest of mankind...

- did not repent of the works of their hands that they should not worship demons and idols of gold, silver, bronze, stone and wood...
- nor did they repent of their murders, or their sorceries, or their sexual immorality or their thefts.

Revelation 10:1-7

Then I saw another mighty angel coming down from heaven, wrapped in a cloud, with a rainbow over his head, and his face was like the sun, and his legs like pillars of fire.

He had a little scroll **open** in his hand.

And he set his right foot on the sea, and his left foot on the land, and called out with a loud voice, like a lion roaring.

(Revelation 10:1-3)

When he called out, the seven thunders sounded.

The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.

(Deuteronomy 29:29)

Seal up
what the seven thunders
have said,
and do not write it down.

(Revelation 10:4)

And the angel...
raised his right hand to heaven
and swore by Him who lives forever and ever...

The creator of heaven and earth

that there would be **no more delay**,

but that in the days of the trumpet call to be sounded by the seventh angel, the mystery of God would be fulfilled,

or completed or finished

just as He announced to His servants the prophets.
