The prayers of saints are offered with incense

The first four trumpets

- 1st trumpet one third of plant life burned
- 2nd trumpet one third of the seas turn to blood
- 3rd trumpet one third of the waters poisoned
- 4th trumpet one third of the heavens darkened

Against the natural world

Section 3 – the seven trumpets



"Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth..."

(Revelation 8:13)

- 5th trumpet locust like creatures torment people
- 6th trumpet a vast army kills one third of mankind

Against humanity

The rest of mankind... did not repent of the works of their hands nor give up worshiping demons... nor did they repent of their murders... sorceries... sexual immorality... thefts.

(Revelation 11:18)


Ruin, corrupt
