The harvests of the earth are reaped – Revelation 14:14-20

The first harvest

Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and seated on the cloud **One like a son of man**, with **a golden crown** on His head...

"Put in your sickle, and reap, **for the hour to reap has come**, for the harvest of the earth is fully ripe."

So He who sat on the cloud swung His sickle across the earth, and the earth was reaped.

(Revelation 14:14-16)

The second harvest

Then another angel came out of the temple in heaven, and he too had a sharp sickle.

"Put in your sickle and gather the clusters from the vine of the earth, for its grapes are ripe."

So the angel swung his sickle across the earth and gathered the grape harvest of the earth and threw it into **the great winepress of the wrath of God**.


And they sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying,

All nations will come and worship You, for Your righteous acts have been revealed.



...having now been **justified by His blood**, we shall be saved from **wrath** through Him. (Romans 5:9)

...Jesus, who delivers us from the wrath to come. (1 Thessalonians 1:10)

God did not appoint us to **wrath**, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ... (1 Thessalonians 5:9)

And I heard a loud voice out of the sanctuary...

Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the wrath of God.

Or: foul and loathsome sores, an evil and pernicious ulceration

> So the **first angel** went and poured out his bowl **on the earth**, and **harmful and painful sores** came upon the people who bore the mark of the beast and worshiped its image. (Revelation 16:2)

The second angel poured out his bowl into the sea, and it became like the blood of a corpse, and every living thing died that was in the sea. (Revelation 16:3)

You are just, O Holy One, who is and who was, for You brought these judgments.
For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and You have given them blood to drink.
It is what they deserve!

The **third angel** poured out his bowl **into the rivers and the springs of water**, and they became **blood**.

(See Revelation 16:4-7)

Yes, Lord God the Almighty, true and just are your judgments!

The **fourth angel** poured out his bowl **on the sun**, and it was allowed to scorch people with fire.

They were scorched by the fierce heat, and they cursed the name of God who had power over these plagues.

They did not repent and give Him glory.

(Revelation 16:8-9)

The **fifth angel** poured out his bowl **on the throne of the beast**, and its kingdom was plunged into darkness.

People gnawed their tongues in anguish and **cursed the God of heaven** for their pain and sores and did not repent of their deeds.

(Revelation 16:10-11)

The **sixth angel** poured out his bowl **on the great river Euphrates**, and its water was dried up, to prepare the way for the kings from the east.

And I saw, coming out of the mouth of the **dragon** and out of the mouth of the **beast** and out of the mouth of the **false prophet**, three unclean spirits like frogs.

For they are demonic spirits, performing signs, who go abroad to the kings of the whole world, to assemble them for battle **on the great day of God the Almighty**.

...And they assembled them at the place that in Hebrew is called **Armageddon**.

(Revelation 16:12-16)

Literally: Mount Meggido, where Barak and Gideon won victories

The **sixth angel** poured out his bowl **on the great river Euphrates**, and its water was dried up, to prepare the way for the kings from the east.

The seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple, from the throne, saying, "It is done!" (Revelation 16:17)

And there were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, and **a great earthquake** such as there had never been since man was on the earth, so great was that earthquake.


The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell, and God remembered **Babylon** the great, to make her drain the cup of the wine of **the fury of His wrath**. (Revelation 16:18-19)

And every island fled away, and no mountains were to be found.

And great hailstones,




about one hundred pounds each, fell from heaven on people; and **they cursed God** for the plague of the hail, because the plague was so severe. (Revelation 16:20-21)
