#### **NKJV**:

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."



#### Romans 1:18-19

#### **ESV**:

For **the wrath of God** is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.

For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them.

#### **NKJV**:

For **the wrath of God** is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them.



#### Romans 2:1

#### **ESV**:

Therefore you have no excuse, O man, every one of you who judges. For in passing judgment on another you condemn yourself, because you, the judge, practice the very same things.

#### **NKJV:**

Therefore you are inexcusable, O man, whoever you are who judge, for in whatever you judge another you condemn yourself; for you who judge practice the same things.



#### Romans 3:21-24

But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe.

For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by His grace as a gift,

#### **NKJV**:

But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe.

For there is no difference; for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus... through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus...



**Romans 4:7-8**

#### **ESV**:

Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven,

whose sin is covered.

Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

#### **NKJV**:

Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven,

Whose sin is covered.

Blessed is the man to whom the LORD does not impute iniquity, And in whose spirit there is no deceit.



#### **Romans 5:1-2**

#### **ESV**:

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Through Him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

#### NKJV:

Therefore,
having been justified by faith,
we have peace with God
through our Lord Jesus Christ,

through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.



#### **Romans 6:23**

#### **ESV**:

The wages of sin is **death**, but the free gift of God is **eternal life** in Christ Jesus our Lord.

#### **NKJV**:

The wages of sin is **death**, but the gift of God is **eternal life** in Christ Jesus our Lord.





I am a slave of sin and I can't escape it

#### **Romans 7**

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Or do you not know, brothers—

that the law is binding on a person as long as he lives?

For the married woman is bound by the law to her husband as long as he lives.

But if the husband dies, she is released from the law of marriage.

So then if, while her husband lives, she marries another man, she will be called an adulteress;


but if her husband dies, she is free from that law, so that she is not an adulteress, though she has married another man.

to Him who has been raised from the dead, in order that we may bear fruit for God.





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The Law rules over a person as long as he lives.
(Romans 7:1)



The Law did not die – you did in Christ.

You **died** in Christ and **rose again** 



Just as death ends the bond of marriage, our death ends the rule of the Law over us.



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For while we were living in the flesh, our sinful passions, aroused by the law, were at work in our members to bear fruit for death.

But now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive, so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit and not in the old way of the written code.


Paul, if you are saying that I must die to the Law, then you are saying that the Law is sin!!!

What shall we say then?

Is the law sin?

By no means!

If it had not been for the law,
I would not have known sin.
(Romans 7:7)

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If it had not been for the law, I would not have known sin.

To desire or crave something that is not yours.

For I would not have known what it is to covet if the law had not said, "You shall not covet."

..

And the commandment, which was to bring life, I found to bring death.

The 10<sup>th</sup> commandment

Because I could not keep it.

(See Romans 7:7-11)

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So, the problem is not the law, it's me!

So then, the law is holy, and the commandment is holy, righteous, and good.

(Romans 7:12)

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Paul, are you saying that God's **goodness**, as seen in the Law, caused your death!?!

## Did that which is good, then, become death to me?

#### **Absolutely not!**

But **sin**, so that it would be shown to be **sin**, produced death in me **through** what is good... (Romans 7:13)

For we know that the law is spiritual, but I am carnal, sold under sin.

(Romans 7:14)

Of the flesh, a "natural man"

A slave to sin

For I do not understand my own actions.

For **I do not do** what I want, but **I do** the very thing I hate.

Now if I do what I do not want,

I agree with the law, that it is good.

So now it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells within me.

(Romans 7:15-17)

For I have **the desire** to do what is right, **but not the ability** to carry it out.

#### **Romans 7:18**

#### **ESV**:

For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh.

For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out.

#### **NKJV**:

For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells;

for to will is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find.
