

23. The destruction of Babylon




From the parable of the sower...

Do not love the world or the things in the world...

- the desires of the flesh
- the desires of the eyes
- the pride of life

—is not from the Father but is from the world. And **the world is passing away**...


The prostitute represents the true nature of the world.



Then a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone and threw it into the sea, saying,

The sound of harpists and musicians, of flute players and trumpeters, will be heard in you no more at all, and a craftsman of any craft will be found in you **no more at all**, and the sound of the mill will be heard in you no more at all, and the light of a lamp will shine in you no more at all, and the voice of bridegroom and bride will be heard in you no more at all ... (Revelation 18:22-23)

And in her was found the **blood** of **prophets** and of **saints**, and of all who have been slain on earth. (Revelation 18:23-24)

And the kings of the earth, an who committed sexual immorality fle and lived in luxury with her, will weep and wail over her when they see the smoke of her burning.

The ten horns ... and the beast will hate the prostitute. They will make her desolate and naked, and devour her flesh and burn her with fire... (Revelation 17:16)

They will stand far off, in fear of her torment, saying,

"Alas! Alas! You great city, you mighty city, Babylon! For in one hour your judgment has come."

And the merchants of the earth weep and mourn for her, since **no one buys their cargo anymore**, cargo of gold, silver, jewels, pearls, ...

... cattle and sheep, horses and chariots, and slaves, that is, human souls.

"The fruit for which your soul longed has gone from you, and all your delicacies and your splendors are lost to you, **never to be found again**!" (Revelation 18:11-14)

Every **shipmaster**, all who travel by ship, **sailors**, and as many as **trade on the sea**, stood at a distance and cried out when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying,

"What is like this great city?"

They threw dust on their heads and cried out, weeping and wailing, and saying,

"Alas, alas, that great city, in which all who had ships on the sea became rich by her wealth! For in one hour she is made desolate."

Then I heard another voice from heaven saying,

Come out of her, My people,

lest you take part in her **sins**, lest you share in her **plagues**; for her sins are heaped high as heaven, and God has remembered her iniquities. (Revelation 18:4-5) Revelation 16:19

Pay her back as she herself has paid back others, and repay her double for her deeds;
mix a double portion for her in the cup she mixed.
As she glorified herself and lived in luxury, so give her a like measure of torment and mourning, since in her heart she says,

- I sit as a queen,
- I am no widow,
- and mourning I shall never see.

(Revelation 18:6-7)

For this reason her plagues will come **in a single day**, death and mourning and famine, and she will be **burned up with fire**; for mighty is the Lord God who has judged her. (Revelation 18:8)
