

Revelation 19:1-10

Part 1 (19:1-5) Heaven rejoices over God's judgement of Babylon

Part 2 (19:6-9) *"The marriage of the Lamb has come"*

Then a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone and threw it into the sea, saying,

So will Babylon the great city be thrown down with violence, **and will be found no more at all...** (Revelation 18:21)


all you His servants, you who fear Him, small and great."

Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of **thunder**, crying out, "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God the Almighty **reigns**. Let us rejoice and exult and give Him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His Bride has made herself ready; it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure"... (Revelation 19:6-8)

The righteous deeds of the saints.

> And the angel said to me, "Write this: *Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb."* And he said to me, "These are the true words of God." (Revelation 19:9)

A Jewish wedding:

- The betrothal
- The dowry
- Preparation
- The wedding procession
- The wedding feast

Christ and the Church:
The Word became flesh
Purchased by His blood
This present age
"Come Lord Jesus"

Eternal joy in His presence

• The **BRIDE**

- One church, one salvation, one Saviour
- **United** with Him in love forever

 The GUESTS invited to the wedding feast

Matthew 22:1-14	

- One church, many members
- Individually invited to share the joy
- **Personal** responsibility to be ready

• The **BRIDE**


 The GUESTS invited to the wedding feast

- ...His bride has made herself ready.
- It was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure.... (Revelation 19:7-8)
- Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming.

(Matthew 25:13)

- Am I **confident in the grace** that alone makes this glorious relationship possible?
- Am I actively seeking to be prepared for the coming of the Lord?
- Do I understand the **good works** that I am called to walk in? (Ephesians 2:10)

Worship God,


for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."


(Revelation 19:10)
