
Concerning prophecy...

Prophecy is not proleptic history.


It is not detailed history in advance



The Lord usually uses natural means


- The captivity of Israel

Man of sin, the lawless one (2 Thessalonians 2:3,8) And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great red dragon, with seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads seven diadems. (Revelation 12:3)
