# What then shall we say to these things? (Romans 8:31)

### What things?

Romans 1:16 ....... The Gospel is **the power of God** for salvation...

Romans 3:10 ...... There is **none righteous**, no, not one...

Romans 5:1 ......... Having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ...

Romans 6:2 ......... How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?

Romans 8:14 ...... All who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.

Romans 8:28 ...... For those who love God all things work together for good...

Romans 8:29-30 .. Foreknown, predestined, called, justified, glorified.

### If God is for us, who can be against us?

He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him graciously give us all things?

### Who shall bring any charge against God's elect?

It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died
—more than that, who was raised—
who is at the right hand of God,
who indeed is interceding for us.




