### > Our view of Israel's place in God's purposes


Romans 11:11 – "Have they stumbled that they should fall?"

# Asking the right questions...

Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age? (Matthew 24:3)



Therefore you also be ready... (Matthew 24:44)

Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel? (Acts 1:6) It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. (Acts 1:7)

"Behold, I am coming soon! Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book. (Revelation 22:7)


# Asking the right questions...

Symbols are **not** symbols of nothing. They represent **REAL THINGS**.

# The revelation of Jesus Christ

The revelation **from** Jesus Christ but also the revelation **about** Jesus Christ

## The revelation of Jesus Christ,

which God gave Him to show to His servants the things that must soon take place. (Revelation1:1)

Truly, truly, I say to you, we speak of what we know, and bear witness to what we have seen.... (John 3:11)

... which God gave Him to show to <u>His servants</u> the things that **must soon take place**.



# The revelation of Jesus Christ

which God gave Him... **Jesus Christ** His angel John the apostle **Seven churches** in Asia (the Roman province)
