

and whoever says, 'You fool!' will be liable to the hell of fire.








Let a person examine <u>himself</u>... and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. (1 Corinthians 11:28)

And if your **right hand** causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away.

For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body go into hell.

Do not let sin reign in your mortal body, to make you **obey** its passions. (Romans 6:12)


