• A person who is **known**, **loved** and **called**.

#### ✓ Known

• Everything is known – past, present and future

#### ✓ Loved

• Perfectly and forever – despite everything

### ✓ Called

• To wisdom, knowledge, fruitfulness, adventure and joy

#### ✓ Loved

 $\checkmark$  Then I know the Lord will not ask of me more than I can give

- > The Christian life is not a sprint it is your whole life, and more.

X No, I just want to have lots of money and friends...

#### > Do you want to bless your family, the church and the world?

"I have but one passion: It is He, it is He alone." — Count Zinzendorf


### 3. How are you willing to live?
