

Laodicea in history

It was founded c. 255 BC by the Greek king Antiochus II, and named after his wife, Laodice. With **fertile soil** and situated on **trade routes**, it grew to be important and very **wealthy**.



A strong **Greek** influence is evident and there was a large **Jewish** population. Laodicea was known for its trade in **black wool** and for medical products, even an **eye salve**.


Laodicea in the New Testament

(Revelation 3:17)






- gold refined by fire, so that you may be rich


