



Genesis 8:20-22

**Then Noah built an altar to the LORD...
and offered burnt offerings on the altar.**

And when the LORD smelled the pleasing aroma,
the LORD said in His heart,
“I will never again curse the ground because of man,
for the intention of man's heart is evil from his youth.”
(Genesis 8:20-21)

Or “even though...”?



Genesis 8:20-22

*Love your enemies...
For He makes His sun rise
on the evil and on the good...
(Matthew 5:44-45)*

While the earth remains,

- seedtime and harvest,
- cold and heat,
- summer and winter,
- day and night,

shall not cease.

(Genesis 8:22)



Genesis 9:1-7

What HAS NOT changed...

And God blessed Noah and his sons
and said to them,

“Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth.”

(Genesis 9:1)



And God blessed them. And God said to them,
“Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth
and subdue it, and have dominion...”

(Genesis 1:28)

Genesis 9:1-7

What HAS changed...

“The **fear of you** and the **dread of you** shall be upon every beast of the earth and upon every bird of the heavens...”
(Genesis 9:2)

“Whoever sheds the blood of man, **by man shall his blood be shed**, for God made man **in His own image.**”
(Genesis 9:5-6)

“**Every moving thing that lives shall be food for you.**”

“And as I gave you the green plants, I give you everything.

“But you shall not eat flesh with **its life**, that is, **its blood.**”

(Genesis 9:3-4)

Genesis 9:8-17


“Never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth.”

(Genesis 9:11)

Then God said to Noah and to his sons with him,

*“Behold, I establish my covenant with you
and your offspring after you,
and with every living creature that is with you...”*

(Genesis 9:8-10)

Now the sons of Noah who went out of the ark
were **Shem, Ham, and Japheth**. ...

These three were the sons of Noah, and
from these the whole earth was populated.



Genesis 9:20-29



Noah began to be a man of the soil,
and he planted a vineyard.

He drank of the wine and became drunk
and lay uncovered in his tent.

And Ham, the father of Canaan,
saw the nakedness of his father
and told his two brothers outside.

(Genesis 9:20-22)


Genesis 9:20-29

When Noah awoke from his wine and knew what his youngest son had done to him, he said,

The lowest place

“Cursed be Canaan;
a servant of servants shall he be
to his brothers.”

(Genesis 9:24-25)



Genesis 9:20-29

The God of Shem!

He also said,

“Blessed be the LORD, the God of Shem;
and let Canaan be his servant.

“May God enlarge Japheth,
and let him dwell in the tents of Shem,
and let Canaan be his servant.”

(Genesis 9:26-27)

Increase in number

Genesis 9:20-29

By faith Noah ... became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.
(Hebrews 11:7)

After the flood Noah lived **350** years.

All the days of Noah were **950** years, and he died.
(Genesis 9:28-29)

...even if these three men,
Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it,
they would deliver but their own lives...
(Ezekiel 14:14)

...if he did not spare the ancient world,
but preserved **Noah**,
a preacher of righteousness...
(2 Peter 2:5)

Cush fathered **Nimrod**;
he was the first on earth to be a mighty man.

The beginning of his kingdom was **Babel...**

(See Genesis 10:8-12)

...from these
the nations spread abroad on the earth
after the flood.

(Genesis 10:32)

Rebellion... Genesis 11:1-9


Now the whole earth had one language and the same words.

(Genesis 11:1)

“Come, let us build ourselves a city and a tower with its top in the heavens, and let us make a name for ourselves, **lest we be dispersed over the face of the whole earth.**”

And the LORD came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of man had built.

(Genesis 11:4-5)



Rebellion...

And the LORD said,
“Behold, they are one people,
and they have all one language,
and this is only the beginning
of what they will do....

“Come, let us go down and there
confuse their language,
so that they may not understand
one another's speech.”

**So the LORD dispersed them from there
over the face of all the earth,**
and they left off building the city.



Terah and Abraham


tôlēdôt - to Chapter 25:11

Now these are the generations of Terah. Terah fathered Abram, Nahor, and Haran; and Haran fathered Lot....

Terah took Abram his son and Lot... and they went forth together from **Ur of the Chaldeans** to go into the land of **Canaan**, but when they came to **Haran**, they settled there.

The days of Terah were 205 years, and **Terah died in Haran.**

(Genesis 11:27-32)

Now the LORD said to Abram,

**“Go from your country and your kindred
and your father's house
to the land that I will show you.**

“And I will make of you a great nation,
and I will bless you
and make your name great,
so that you will be a blessing.

“I will bless those who bless you,


