WHY DO WE MEET?




EPH2:19 Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, 20 having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief *cornerstone*, 21 in whom the whole building, being **fitted together, grows into a holy temple** in the Lord, 22 in whom you also are **being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.**

1 Cor 3: 9 For we are God's fellow workers; you are **God's field**, *you are* **God's building**. 10 According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and **another builds on it**. But let each one take heed how he builds on it. +



Eph 4:16 from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what **every joint supplies**, according to the effective working by which **every part does its share**, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

TEACHING



- Act2 20:32 “So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the **word** of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.
- 2Tim 3:16 **All Scripture** *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,* 17that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

BREAKING OF BREAD

1 Cor 11: 23 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the *same* night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke *it* and said, **“Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”** 25 In the same manner *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, **“This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me.”**

26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death till He comes.

FELLOWSHIP

Eph 5:19 **speaking to one another** in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart **to the Lord,** +

Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and **admonishing one another** in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts **to the Lord.**

1Cor 14:26 How is it then, brethren? Whenever you⁺ come together, each of you has a psalm, has a teaching, has a tongue, has a revelation, has an interpretation. **Let all things be done for edification.**

PRAYER

- Acts 1:14 These all continued **with one accord in prayer and supplication**
- Acts 4:24 So when they heard that, they raised their voice to God **with one accord**,
- Eph 6:18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and **supplication for all the saints**—
- 19and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel, 20for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.




PRAYER

- Eph 1:15 Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, 16do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: 17that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, **may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him,**



PRAYER



- Col 1:9 For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that **you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding**
- Col4:2 Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving; 3meanwhile praying also for us, that God would **open to us a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ**, for which I am also in chains, ;
