The Gospel According to **JOHN**

CHAPTER 1

1 **I**N the beginning ^awas the Word,
and the ^bWord was ^cwith God,
and the Word was ^aGod.
2 ^aHe was in the beginning with
God.
3 ^aAll things were made through
Him, and without Him nothing was
made that was made.
4 ^aIn Him was life, and ^bthe life
was the light of men.
5 And ^athe light shines in the
darkness, and the darkness did not
comprehend it.
6 There was a ^aman sent from
God, whose name was John.
7 This man came for a ^awitness,
to bear witness of the Light, that
all through him might ^bbelieve.
8 He was not that Light, that
sent to bear witness.
9 ^aThat Light, which came into the
world, is the true Light, which
gives life to all who receive Him.
10 ^aWho does not receive Him,
the same is the one who has
not seen the Light, and has
not heard the voice of the
Word, and has not seen the
glory of the Father, who
has sent the Son into the
world.
11 ^aThis is the testimony which
John gave, when the Jews
and the Pharisees came to
him at Jerusalem for the
feast of the Dedication.
12 ^aThen said John to them,
^b"I baptize with water, but
there stands One among you
whom you do not know."
13 ^aHe is the One who comes
after me, ^bwhose shoes I am
not worthy to untie.

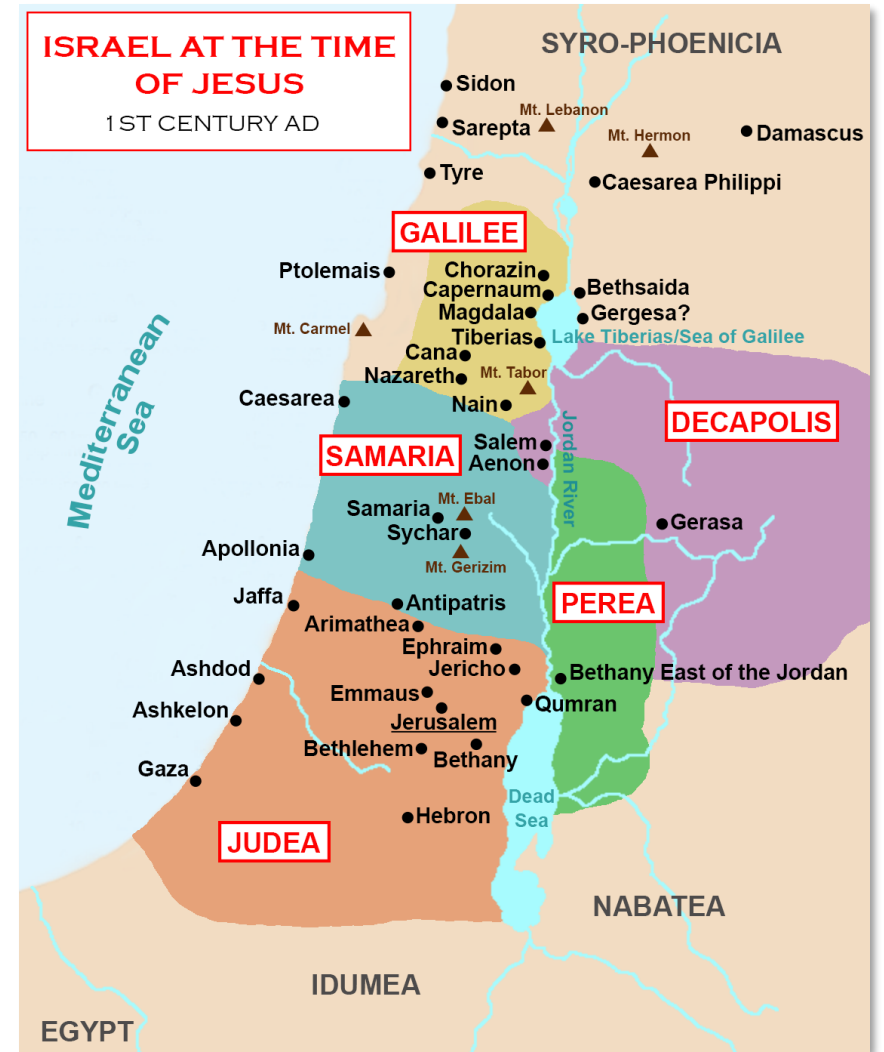

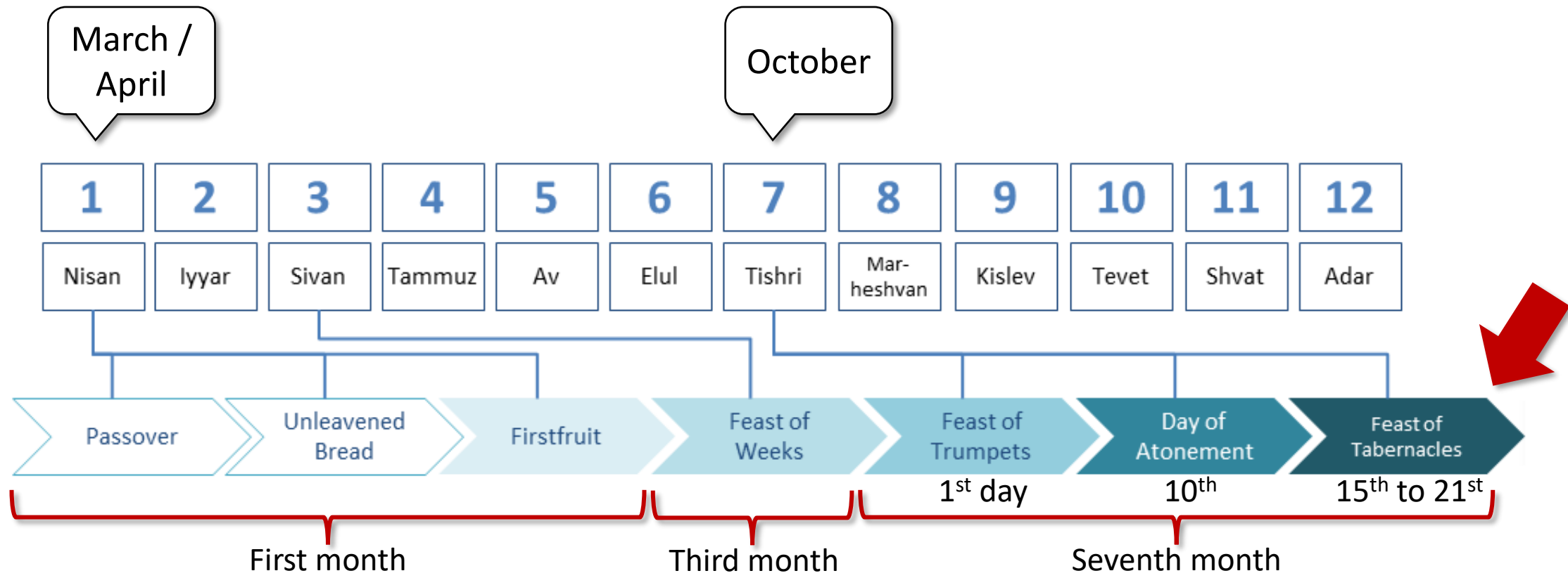
After this Jesus went about in **Galilee**.

“If on the Sabbath a man receives circumcision,
so that the law of Moses may not be broken,
are you angry with me because on the Sabbath
I made a man’s whole body well?

A sign of
salvation
through faith

**“Do not judge by appearances,
but judge with right judgment.”**

Rivers of living water!

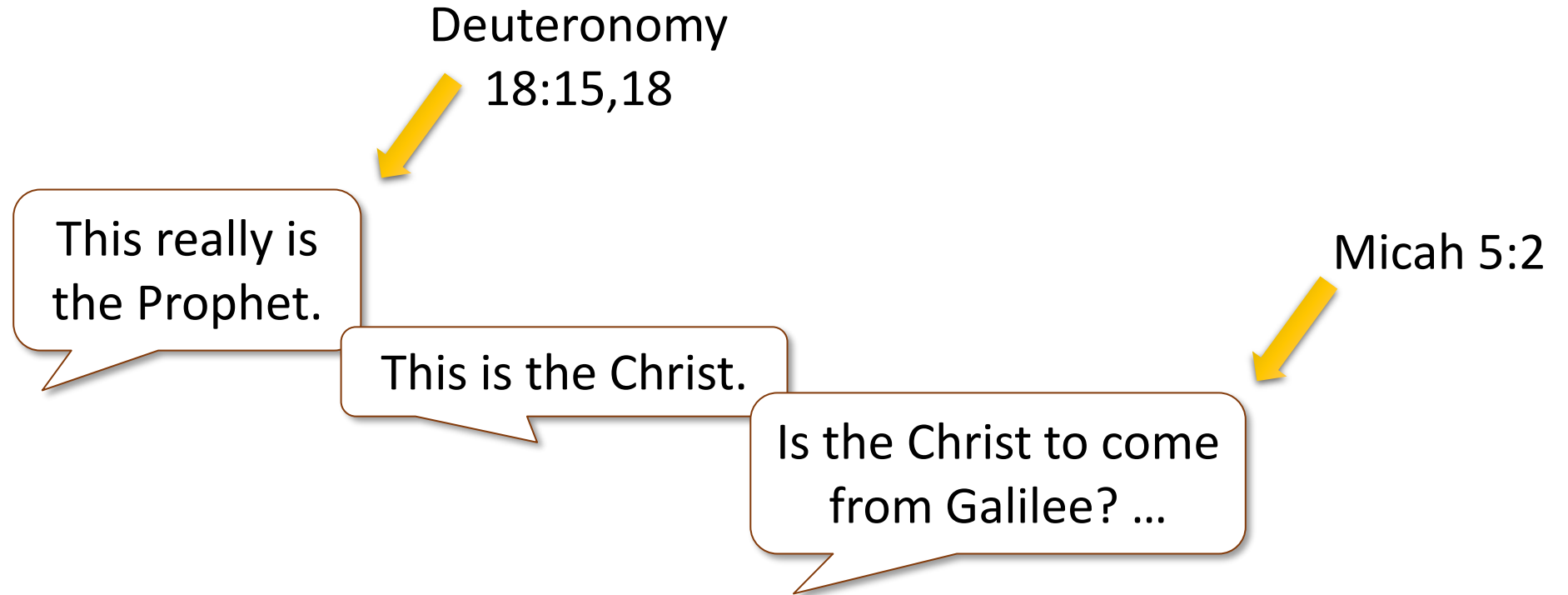
Now this He said about the Spirit,
